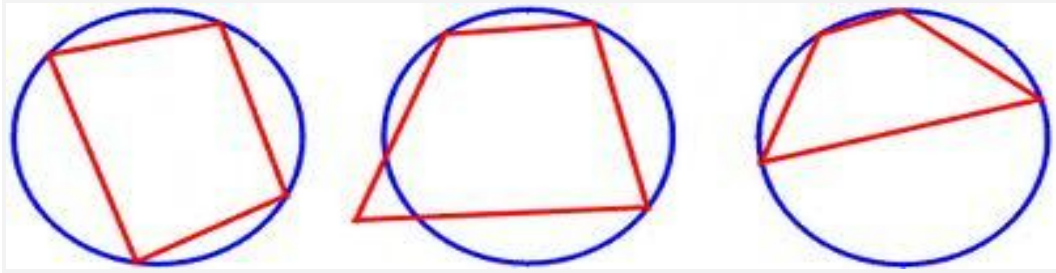


CIRCUMSCRIBED
